Regulations/Information for completing Electrical Permit Application

Electrical work shall not be started until the application for permit has been filed. All installations shall be in conformance with the Michigan Electrical Code. No work shall be concealed until it has been inspected. When ready for for an inspection, call the inspector and provide as much advance notice as possible. Provide the job location and permit number to the inspector.

EXPIRATION OF PERMIT: A permit remains valid as long as work is progressing and inspections are requested and conducted with the first year of issuance. A permit shall become invalid if the authorized work is not commenced within (6) months after issuance of the permit or if the authorized work is suspended or abandoned for a period of (6) months after the time commencing the work. A PERMIT WILL BE CANCELLED WHEN NO INSPECTIONS ARE REQUESTED AND CONDUCTED WITHIN (6) MONTHS OF THE DATE OF CANCELLED WHEN NO INSPECTIONS ARE REQUESTED AND CONDUCTED WITHIN (6) MONTHS OF DATE OF ISSUANCE OF THE DATE OF ISSUANCE OR THE DATE OF A PREVIOUS INSPECTION.

***Mobil Home Park Site:**

When installing a site service in a park, the permit application must include the application fee, service, plus the number of park sites.

When setting a HUD mobile home in a park, a permit must include the application fee and a feeder. This shall be done by a licensed electrical contractor.

When setting a HUD mobile home or a permanufactures home on private property, a permit must include the application fee, service and feeder.

Please Note: Most Electrical permits MUST be accompanied by Building permits

NOTE: Commercial property or rental property must have all work completed by electrical contractor.

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NOTE: State of Michigan Law: Any Business has to use ELECTRICAL CONTRACTOR to pull Electrical Permit

New Building Inspections; A/C included with new home and don't need to pull separate electrical permit

1. CEE-is required inspection per State Law (concrete encased electrodes) ((RE-ROD)
(This Inspection done by Building Inspector)
2. Temporary Service (not always required, ask person pulling permit.)
3. Service
4. Rough
5. Final

FOR ELECTRICAL SERVICE TURN ON: The Owner must do the following for power Turn On

- 1) Purchase Electrical Permit at Township (1) service Inspection
- 2) Make all service upgrades necessary, by homeowner or Electrical Contractor
- 3) And bring Service up to current Michigan Electrical Code
- 4) If Inspection fails, additional inspection fees will be necessary
- 5) Call the power company for notification number and give number to electrical inspector along with Electrical Permit Number and Address. The Building must be accessible to the Inspector.

CONSUMERS ENERGY NOTIFICATION NUMBER is needed for service to be turned on. The homeowner requests number from Consumers Energy at 1-800-477-5050 then passes on to the Electrical Contractor and Electrical Inspector.

Note: Ok to issue permit without Notification #. Applicant is responsible for obtaining one ASAP.
