Call to Order and Pledge: 7:00 p.m.

Present: Lance, Morency, McAlister, Kitley, and 7 residents. **Absent:** Walz.

Grant Bauman of the Region 2 Planning Commission will be visiting at the next Planning Commission meeting to discuss updating our maps. They also are looking at the Summit Township Noise Ordinance to help in reworking ours.
